

JANUARY 8-9 | MOVE-IN PROCESS: WHAT TO EXPECT

1 SCHEDULE

To facilitate physical distancing, you will need to schedule a Move-In day and time January 8-9 using the [Housing Portal](#). Please plan to arrive at the French Field House at your scheduled Move-In time for testing prior to going to your Residence Hall.

If you have extenuating circumstances that make it necessary to move in outside of these testing times, you must go to the Drackett Tower, Morrill Tower or Park Stradley front desk to receive an antigen test that you will be expected to complete before going to your room.

2 ARRIVE AND PARK

When traveling to campus to begin Move-In, please proceed to the French Field House for your antigen test. You should approach the French Field House south parking lot, accessible from Woody Hayes Drive.

3 ANTIGEN TESTING CHECK-IN

The test will take approximately 15 minutes.

4 ON-CAMPUS ANTIGEN TEST

If your test is negative, you will be approved to move into your residence hall during your scheduled time.

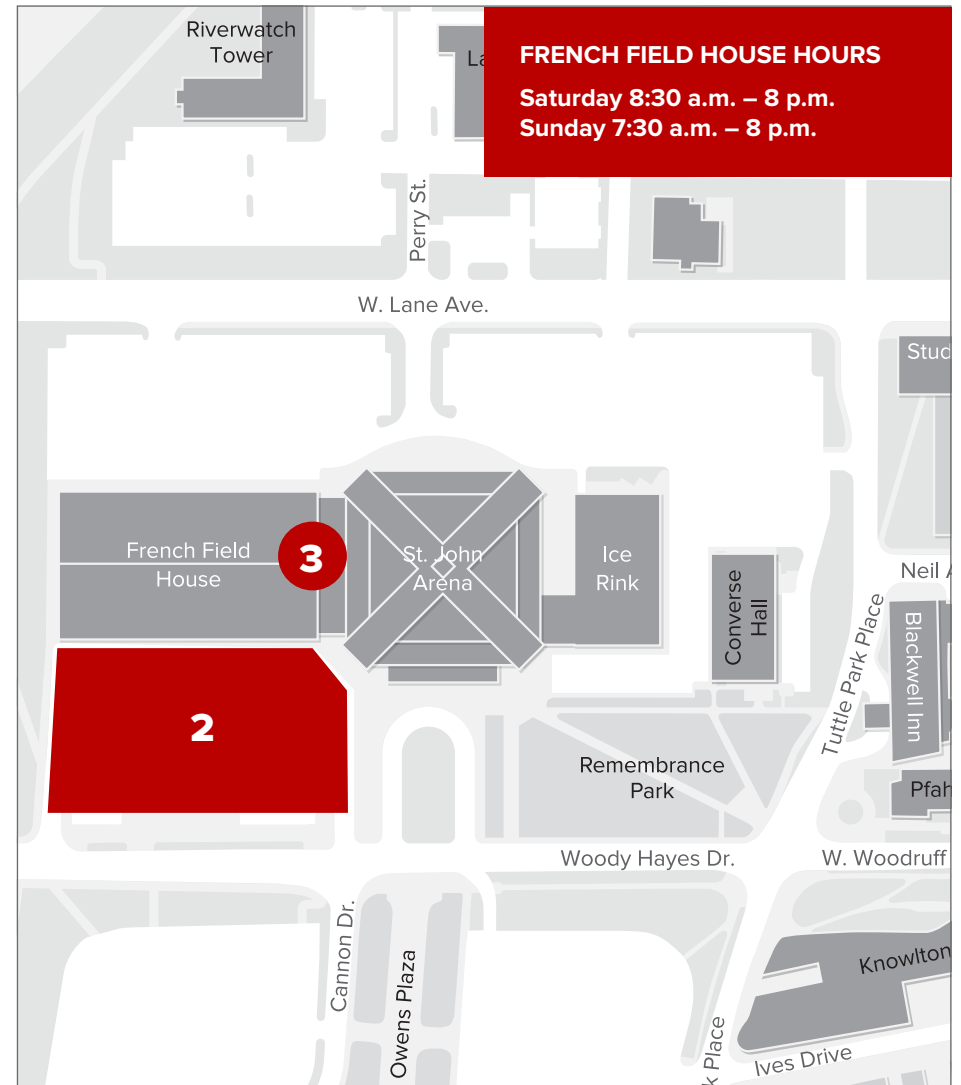
Those who test positive will not be able to move in and instead will need to isolate for five days, either at home or in a local hotel (see the [Safe and Healthy Buckeyes website](#) for recommended spaces in the Columbus area).

Limited beds in the on-campus isolation residence hall will be prioritized for out-of-state students on a first-come, first-served basis, and space is not guaranteed.

After five days of isolation, students will be able to attend classes in person if they are symptom-free, and they wear a well-fitted mask both indoors and outdoors for the next five days.

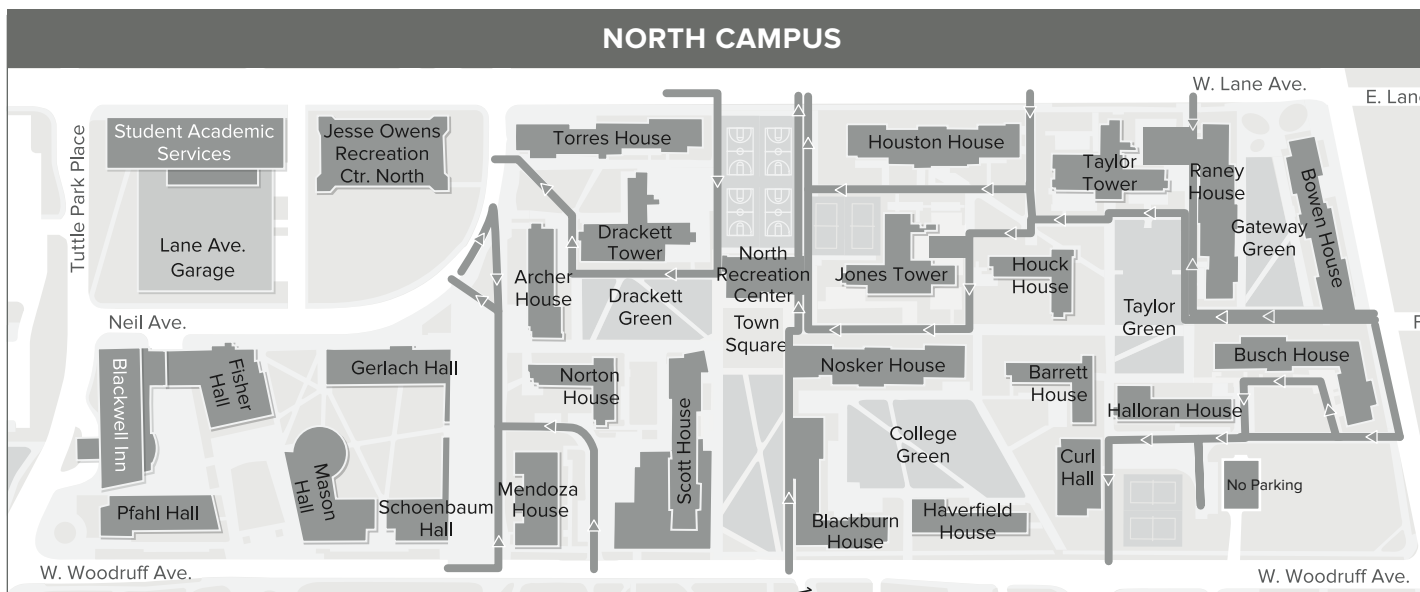
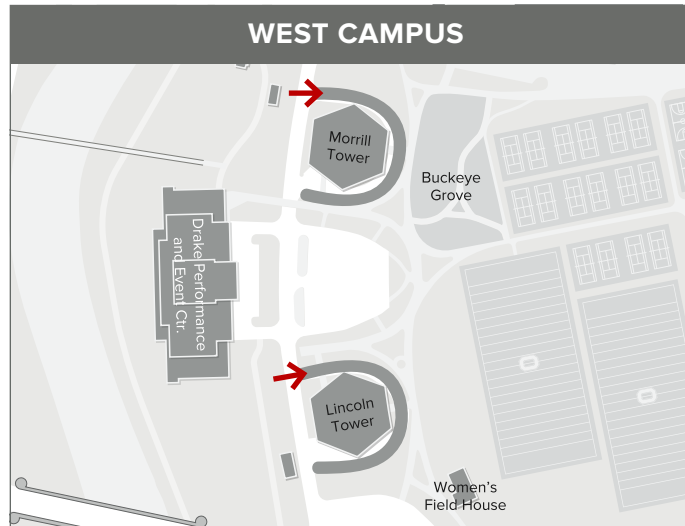
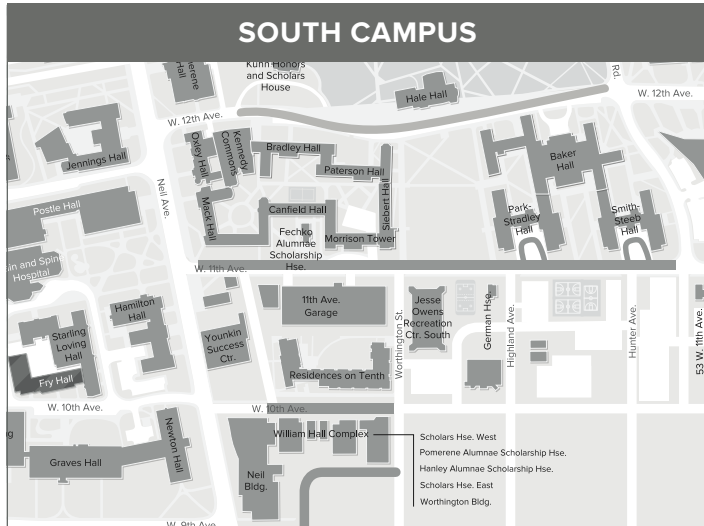
5 PROCEED TO YOUR RESIDENCE HALL

Once you have received a negative antigen test, you may proceed to your residence hall to unload your belongings and check into your residence hall. Family members will need to remain in the vehicle while you are unloading.

TESTING REQUIREMENTS

As a student living in university-managed housing, you are required to test weekly regardless of your vaccination status. Your first weekly test must be completed by the end of the day Friday, January 14. Tests must be scheduled in advance using MyChart. **Remember to complete PCR test at Jesse Owens North by January 14.**

MASK REQUIREMENTS

Until further notice, students, faculty, staff and visitors to all Ohio State campuses and medical facilities are required to wear masks indoors, regardless of their vaccination status. Masks continue to be required outdoors for unvaccinated individuals when they cannot maintain physical distancing. Vaccinated people are not required to mask outdoors. TRAFFIC AND PARKING

All regular university traffic and parking rules and regulations apply. Customized notifications on traffic, construction, weather and other incidents affecting your route to campus are available through the OHGO app from the Ohio Department of Transportation.

If you arrive to campus via rideshare, transportation to your residence hall will be provided after receiving a negative test.
